(a) Chairman's Terms and Concept of Operations.
The EIRB will provide recommendations on NEPA issues to the commanding officer.

(b) Concept of Operations.
The EIRB will serve to assess environmental consequences of significant proposed actions that could affect the quality of the environment.

(c) Coordinate with the Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA).
The EIRB will ensure that the environmental impact of proposed actions is consistent with NEPA requirements.

(d) Ensure NEPA document adequacy by legal, Standing members of the EIRB are as follows:

1. Executive Officer
2. Counsel
3. Operations Officer (S-3)
4. Installations and Logistics Officer (S-4)
5. Public Works Officer
6. Community Plans and Liaison Officer (S-5)
7. Environmental Management Officer (S-7) (Chairman of EIRB)

(e) The Chairman of EIRB will invite department or representatives to participate in board discussions on environmental impacts at initial planning stages.

(f) Review all Environmental Impact Statements (EISs) and make recommendations as appropriate.

(g) Assist action sponsors in determining the requisite level of NEPA documentation required.

(h) Review all Environmental Assessment (EAs) and EISs.

(i) Coordinating Instructions.
(a) The EIRB will meet at the discretion of the Chairman.
(b) All EIRB members will familiarize themselves with the scope and general content of the reference.

(c) The Environmental Management Officer will coordinate the activities of the EIRB to include distribution of all documents for EIRB and staff review, coordination of EIRB meetings, preparation of meeting minutes and promulgation of all NEPA documents as directed by the EIRB and the commanding officer.

(d) The MCAS Miramar Executive Officer and the EIRB officer are delegated "By direction" authority of the commanding officer to sign Categorical Exclusion decision memoranda.
